Brian Gallien, of Ironwood Restoration in Marlow, N.H., works to rebuild the bandstand in Claremont's Broad Street Park. The \$33,500 project to restore the structure after its roof was blown off during a 1999 storm is nearly complete. No original design plans for the 75-year-old gazebo could be found, so Gallien, who has been working solo on the project for months, had to start from scratch by taking measurements.
